

ART168 The Digital Medium Project 1: Fact/Fiction: Exquisite Corpse Create a photographic collage that combines various digital images. The source image content used for this project should come from both Generated & Found locations. Found images should incorporate image search techniques explored in class that yield content with Creative Commons licenses. Generated images must be created through digital photography or digital scanner with appropriate resolution, and should be created new for the project. You must incorporate a minimum of four different images. Consideration must be paid to image resolution and pixel dimension as well as color, contrast, and saturation. The combined images should create juxtaposition between what is fact and what is fiction. A good example would be the image generated in the Digital Foundations Chapter 9 exercise. However, this shouldn't be a limitation or expectation for what you are to do. With this project, your task is to take things that aren't normally found together and remix them. The final product could be either a believable fiction or one that is fantastical. Technical issues that must be resolved with Project 1 include the possible differing resolutions, color space, and pixel dimensions. Conceptual issues in Project 1 revolve around inventive visual statement.

Objectives

- Use Photoshop tools to create a digital image collage from various sources
- Active use and understanding of file formats, archiving, and storage of digital files
- Resolve potentially disparate image resolutions and sizes
- Investigate conceptual potential within digital image collage
- Develop use of vocabulary surrounding digital image manipulation
- Solve visual and conceptual problems with creativity, invention, and self-expression
- Participation in discussion and critique, submission by deadline
- Use of Printing technology and "Save For Web" for presentation **Requirements One (1)**
