Project: Final Group Animation: 300 POINTS



- Create an opening to an original TV show or movie title sequence within a group of your peers, using traditional 2D animation techniques.
- The show concept can be anything you want, but it must be an original idea.
- The show can be animated or live action, but the opener must be at least 80% animated.
- Every member must share in the animation.
- As a team, develop the basic premise of the show.
- The opening should introduce the premise or main character relationships of the show.
- Figure out who your target audience is.
- Elect a **Producer** from the group someone who is responsible and will keep order
- Develop this animation from its initial preproduction phases (script, character designs, environment layouts, storyboard), its production phases (hand drawn, scanning, stop motion, software, etc...), and finally to its post-production (sound, editing, effects, etc).
- Characters are not required in the opening. You may use motion graphics.
- You may use other software not provided by the school.
- Do not use any copyrighted material or preexisting action figures/toys.
- You may use your own equipment.
- Sound is required.
- If your group decides to have characters, you MUST record yourselves acting out the performance. Reference will be presented.
- If your characters require lip-sync, you **MUST** have at least one group member that has turned in the Extra Credit Lip-Sync project.
- You will come to class and *visually* show your current progress to the professor and class everyday.
- Length
 - 30 90 seconds of animation (concept and group size depending)
 - o Each member must animate at least 7 seconds.
- Resolution
 - 1280x720 (or larger 16:9)
- FPS
 - o **24**
- Quicktime Movie
 - o **H.264**
- Due dates
